Q: Who is your favorite bible character?

A: Mary, the mother of Jesus

Yes. Mary is my favorite bible character. As a young adult, I often found myself drawn to Mary's encounter with the messenger Gabriel. She hears and receives the words of Good News we all need to hear all the time (Do not be afraid. God is with you.). Mary receives a promise of God's favor that we see in our own baptisms (You are mine. You are good enough!) And, my personal favorite, she responds, in good musical theater fashion, with a song: The Magnificat. Mary's first-person testimony of all that we can trust God to do to bring change and new life in God's relationship with us: Showing mercy, breaking spiritual pride, casting down the mighty, exalting the lowly, authoring trust and giving all creation good things

I share "adoration" and love of Mary with you because as a church, we are looking forward to my installation as Adoration's pastor on August 15th -- which, by a coincidence of the Holy Spirit happens to be the day we celebrate Mary, the Mother of our Lord and Bearer of God to the world!
