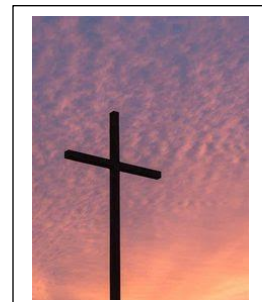
Please do not play on the piano in Fellowship Hall or move it - it is very sensitive, aging and can easily fall out of tune.
