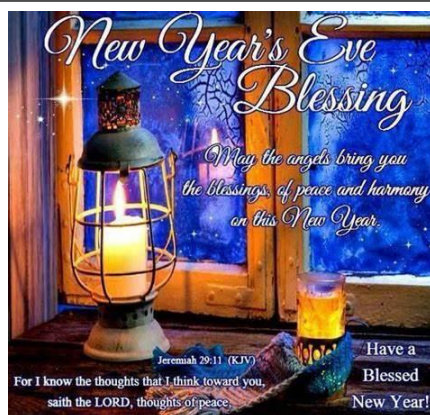

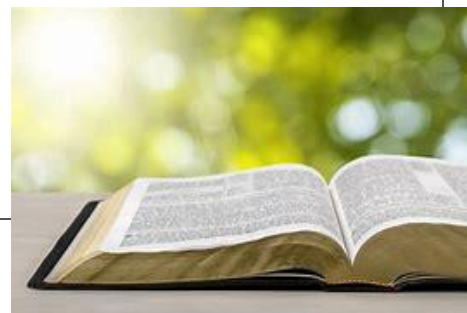

First Songs of Christmas by Nancy De Moss

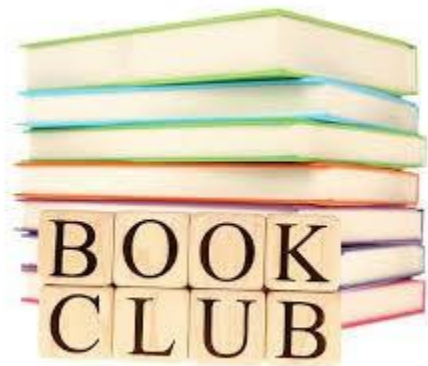
It is a non-fiction book about Advent and Christmas.
