### **Mt. Meru Coffee Available for Purchase**


Adoration has been supporting the Mt. Meru Coffee project for over 20 years. This provides fair market pricing to the coffee farmers in Tanzania. We do not make a profit on this but sell it at cost. The coffee is amazing! We have a good supply in stock, so start thinking about buying some for your household now that the temps are dropping and have extra on-hand for the upcoming holiday season!

- The drip and flavored coffee are \$12.00 per bag
- Peaberry is \$18.00 per bag
- K-Cups are \$9.00 per box


### **Wednesday Morning Bible Study – Adoration**
