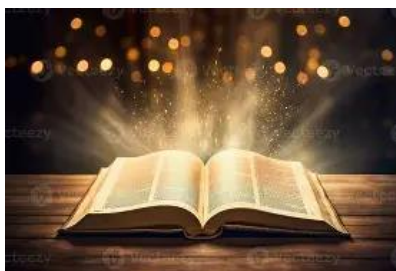
### **Wednesday Morning Bible Study – Adoration**
