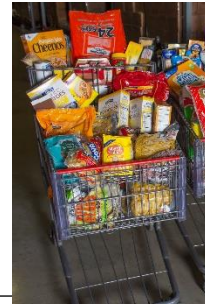

### **Eagle Scout Project - Update on New Playset**

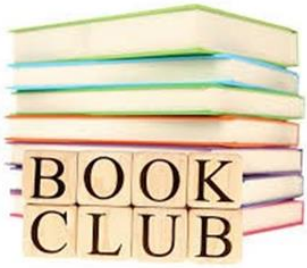
Wayne, Diane and Tyler Anderson were at church on March 23rd. They pulled up the old timbers which will be removed at a later date.
