NOTICE: Highway clean-up this spring has been cancelled due to the construction on Forest Home Avenue.

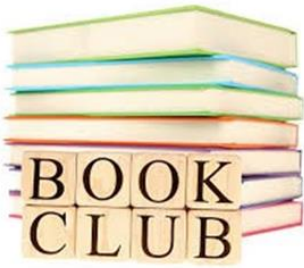

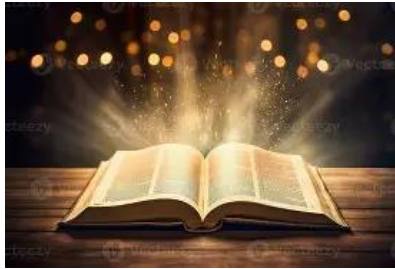
Wednesday Morning Bible Study – Adoration

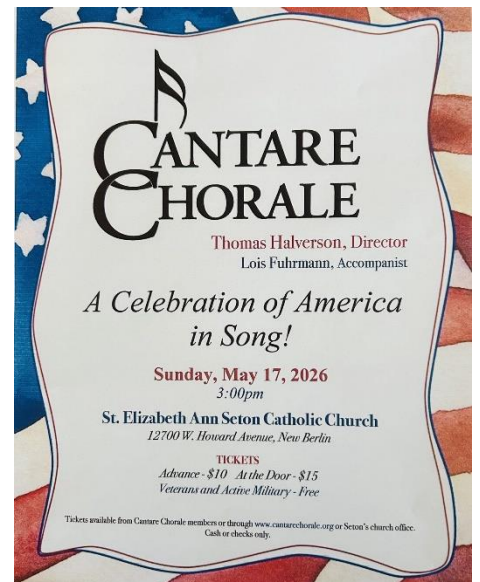


Music Camp – June 15th-19th (Monday-Friday) from 9 a.m.-Noon at St. Luke’s in Greendale
