We really need help mowing the lawn this season and would like to get a weekly schedule in place!

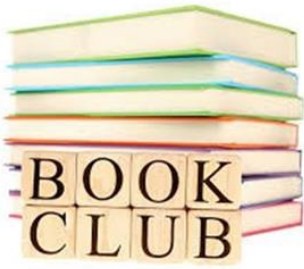

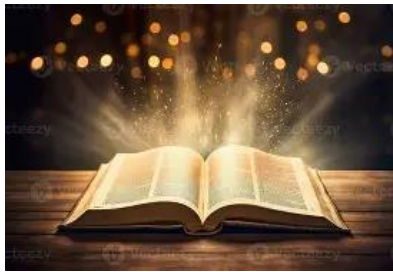
Wednesday Morning Bible Study – Adoration

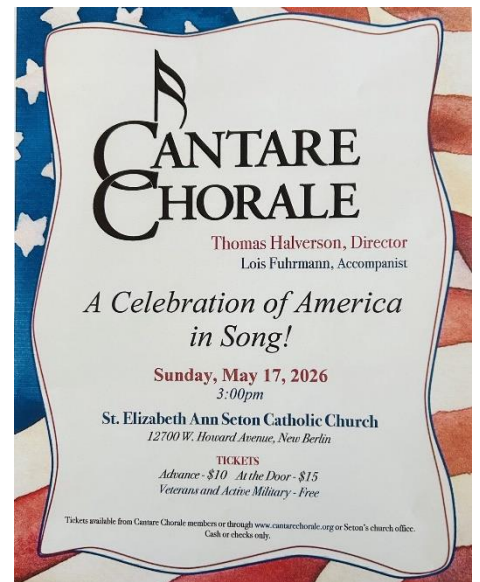


Music Camp – June 15th-19th (Monday-Friday) from 9 a.m.-Noon at St. Luke’s in Greendale
