More details to come in the near future! Just know that there will be great food, amazing people and lots of fun activities for the young ones and those who are young at heart!

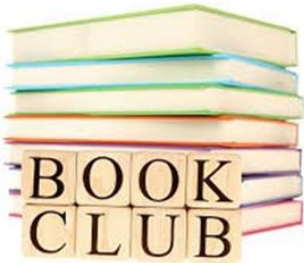
