Adoration's annual meeting was held last Sunday following worship. It was determined a quorum was met. Copies of the reports from committees were printed in the annual report. These reports are still available in the narthex.

The president's report listed many of the positive activities taking place at Adoration. Volunteers provide hard work and contributions to accomplish God's work. Thank you! As your president, I feel we are in a better place than a year ago.

The financial report was examined and approved. Because we are no longer paying a full-time pastor, our expenses have decreased somewhat. In the 2025-2026 year we have received a couple of substantial donations given to support the work of the church which has enabled us to end up back in the black.

Three individuals were elected to council to serve a second term – Craig Beyler, Linda Kolar-Wood and Sharon Anderson. There were no nominations from the floor.

Thank you to everyone who has donated in the past! Your generosity helps those who need a little extra love and support!

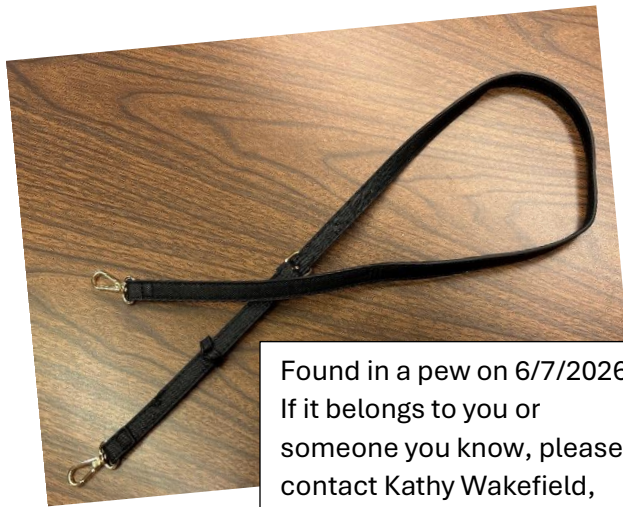
### Mt. Meru Coffee Available for Purchase

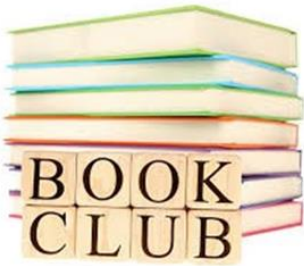
