Your continued donations to the food cart in the back of church have been greatly appreciated by the food pantry and those they continue to serve.

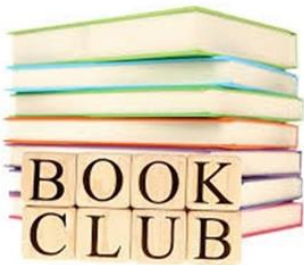
